Position Title: Occupational Therapist

Position Objective: Nature's Way Summer Camp is an urban agricultural experience for children with autism. In its first year of operation, the camp will be held for four days a week for two weeks, June 20-23 and 27-30, 2017, 8 AM – 1 PM. The Camp Occupational Therapist will be responsible for helping to develop the horticultural therapy components of the program as well as assist in organizing other camp related activities.

Occupational Therapists must demonstrate the ability to:

- Assess occupational therapy needs using recognized assessment tools
- Develop OT goals for student
- Help director implement sensory integration strategies within the curriculum
- Work collaboratively with camp staff

- Excellent verbal, written and organizational skills
- Minimum of two years OT experience in a school setting preferred
- Experience in a setting using Applied Behavior Analysis(ABA) strategies preferred
